1	To receive Members' Apologies for Absence		
	Apologies were received and accepted from Cllr Daymond.		
2	To receive Members' Declarations of Interest		
	There were no declarations of interest.		
3	To approve the minutes of the previous meeting of the committee held on		
	16 November 2022		
	Proposed: Cllr Lane Seconded: Cllr Buxton All In Favour		
	'That the minutes of the Community Development & Events Committee meeting held		
	on 16 November 2022 be approved, subject to one minor amendment.'		
4	Public Participation – 15 minutes allowed		
	There were no members of the public present.		
5	To review the Christmas Lights Switch On event and agree actions		
	Members agreed that the event had been a huge success and thanks to a great team		
	effort from Cllrs and staff it was even better attended than ever. The event had come		
	in well under budget thanks to income from stall holders and donations.		
	Santa: It was agreed that the Santa had been a great asset to the event and offered		
	excellent value for money, joining the crowd after his grotto appearance and helping to		
	switch on the lights. It was noted that a donation had been received which covered		
	Santa's fee and the gifts, which enabled the Council to offer the visit free of charge to children.		
	Members agreed that the location of the grotto was ideal, and noted that it proved		
	essential to have volunteers managing the queue at the bottom of the stairs so that		
	the waiting area did not become overcrowded. There were a few children who were		
	unable to visit the grotto due to time constraints and this would be taken into account		
	when the committee starts to plan for the 2023 event.		
	Christmas tree: Members expressed a wish for a larger tree next year and it was		
	agreed to liaise with the Borough Council in advance, or alternatively to explore		
	sponsorship as an option. It was suggested that Cllrs could run a fundraising coffee		
	morning to further support the additional lights it would need. It was agreed that the		
	picket fencing had been an effective addition in preventing vandalism.		

To discuss the viability of the Town Hall cinema (post March 2023) and agree actions

Members discussed the attendance figures and the costs associated with running the cinema. It was noted that the next three films will be shown in conjunction with the Community Hub free of charge to residents, thanks to a Hot Spot grant, although the surround sound would incur a £100 charge.

Opinions were divided with some Cllrs wishing to continue the cinema as a community resource, and others who considered the low attendance figures and costs a reason to discontinue.

Proposed Cllr Lane **Seconded** Cllr Leivers **All in favour** 'To defer a decision about the longer term future of the cinema until after the free period and to run one additional children's film during the Easter Holidays.'
